TTOC Self-Isolation Leave

TTOCs are entitled to self-isolation leave, and should be paid for any time booked prior to the leave that you are unable to work due to the requirement to self-isolate. We understand that this leave doesn't fix all of the issues, and leaves a lot of people out, we continue to advocate locally and provincially for better provisions for TTOCs in self-isolation.

Teacher Evaluations

Teacher performance evaluations are on hold until the end of June, with two exceptions. Teachers can still request an evaluation, and may want one for qualification or reference purposes. The other exception is if your administrator has a specific concern about the performance of teachers in temporary contracts who will be converting to continuing, the union will be notified and an evaluation will be completed.
